Frequently Asked Questions:

How do I sign up?

All signups are done online via Signup Genius. Signups occur every Monday night at 7pm for the following week. Signups are currently limited to a maximum of two (2) swims per week.

I am having trouble signing up! What should I do?

1. Make sure to add the signup page (bit.ly/LosBanosSignUp) to your bookmarks for easy/direct access.
 2. Make sure to have an account registered through Signup Genius (this is not required to sign up, but it will help make things faster by cutting down on the amount of typing you need to do).
 3. On the sign up date, log into Sign-Up Genius prior to 7 pm. Make sure to refresh your web browser as the signup time approaches.
 4. If possible, login using a laptop or PC instead of a tablet or mobile device.
 5. Sign up for one swim at a time. Once signups go live, a *very large* amount of people are all fighting over the same limited amount of reservation times. Signup Genius does not reserve a spot once the time slot has been clicked. Reservations are only confirmed once the submit button has been clicked. This means that during the time it takes to choose a second reservation someone may have already submitted a reservation for the previously chosen time slot. Because of this, swimmers have determined that is quicker to sign up for each swim individually as it has a much higher success rate than attempting to sign up for two at the same time.
 6. Some swimmers have also found success opening and logging into signup genius on multiple tabs within their web browsers. This allows them to access the signup page faster in the event that a reservation they have selected is not available.

What if I need to cancel?

Cancellations can be done online through your Signup Genius account or by calling in to Los Baños between the hours of 7am to 4pm (Mon-Fri).

Frequently Asked Questions Cont.

Can I drop in?

Yes. In the event that a swimmer cancels, does not show up, or is more than ten (10) minutes late to their reservation; open lanes will be given out to drop-in swimmers on a first come, first served basis. When dropping in, please inform the lifeguard staff that you do not have a reservation. They will ask you to wait outside of the facility and will notify after the ten (10) minute wait period if there is space available.

If I want to try and drop-in, when is the best time to show up?

There is no definitive answer to this question. The no-show/cancellation rate at Los Baños del Mar remains very low and we cannot guarantee lane availability to those looking to drop-in. However, evening lap swim and Sunday morning lap swim do tend to have a higher rate than other times throughout the week.

Does a drop-in swim count against my two (2) swims per week?

No. Drop-in swims do not count against the two (2) swim total.

What are your prices? How do I pay?

How many swimmers are allowed per lane?

Lap swim is currently limited to one (1) swimmer per lane. As new public health orders are issued, we will adjust our operations accordingly.

Frequently Asked Questions Cont.

Can members of the same household share a lane?

No. While the current health order does allow for members of the same family to be within 6ft. of each other, allowing two swimmers of the same family in a single lane does not allow us to maintain social distancing from the swimmers in adjacent lanes and so cannot be allowed at this time.

Are the locker rooms open? Are showers available?

The locker rooms and indoor showers remain closed as part of our facility's updated safety measures. Restroom facilities remain open in a limited capacity. There is also a small, cold water shower on the deck located next to the spare lifeguard tower. Please keep shower use limited so that everyone has access to this amenity.
